# CLARIFICATION TEXT ON THE PROTECTION AND PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

This clarification text has been prepared by the Human Rights Foundation of Turkey (HRFT) in accordance with the 3<sup>rd</sup> article of item 20 of the Constitution of the Republic of Turkey and the Law on the Protection of Personal Data numbered 6698 in line with the safety of your personal data and the privacy of personal life principle to inform you, the participants of the International Symposium entitled, "Confronting the Global Human Rights Crisis: Towards a Novel Human Rights Movement".

#### 1. Data Custodian and Representative

The data custodian is the Human Rights Foundation of Turkey (HRFT) located at the address of Mithatpaşa Street Nr: 49/11-12 Kızılay/Ankara. Whereas the representative is the HRFT Izmir Agency located at the address of Alsancak Quarter, 1471. Street, Kenet 1 Block, No.1/1-2 Konak/İzmir.

## 2. Purposes of Collecting and Processing of Personal Data

Your personal data collected when you personally fill out the registration form at <a href="https://tihvakademi.org/sempozyum/">https://tihvakademi.org/sempozyum/</a> are processed in accordance with the data processing conditions and purposes specified in items 5 and 6 of the law numbered 6698 for organizing your participation to the online presentations of the international symposium that will take place during the dates of October 03-07, 2020 and to establish communication with you.

#### 3. To Whom and For What Purposes the Personal Data may be Transferred

Your personal data to be collected including private personal data shall be shared only with HRFT employees and volunteers and with the related government institutions per your request as a means for legal remedies in order to realize the objectives specified in this hereby clarification text.

## 4. Methods and Legal Grounds for the Collection of Personal Data

Your personal data are collected in electronic environment by way of non-automatic methods for actualizing the purposes specified in this hereby clarification text and our related obligations. Your personal data collected on these legal grounds may be processed within the scope of the personal data processing conditions and purposes specified in items 5 and 6 of the law numbered 6698.

#### 5. Durations for Storing Personal Data

Your personal data shall be stored for as long as the relationship established between you and HRFP during the International Symposium entitled "Confronting the Global Human Rights Crisis: Towards a Novel Human Rights Movement" to be organized during October 03-07, 2020 continues and in accordance with the durations stipulated in the related regulations, after which they will be deleted or will be made anonymous.

# 6. Rights of the Personal Data Subject in Accordance with Item 11 of the Law Numbered 6698

In case you convey demands related with your rights as personal data subjects to <a href="mailto:tihv@tihv.org.tr">tihv@tihv.org.tr</a> or <a href="mailto:izmir@tihv.org.tr">izmir@tihv.org.tr</a> via e-mail or to the addresses of Mithatpaşa Street No: 49/11-12 Çankaya/Ankara and Alsancak Quarter, 1471 Street, Kenet 1 Block, No.1/1-2 Konak/İzmir by post HRFT shall finalize your demands free of charge as soon as possible or latest within thirty days subject to the nature of the demand. In this scope, personal data subjects have the rights to;

- Learn whether the personal data are processed or not,
- Request related information if the personal data are processed,
- Learn the purposes of processing personal data and whether the personal data are used in line with these purposes,
- Acquire knowledge on the third parties as the recipients of these personal data to whom these data have been or will be disclosed both domestically and abroad,
- Request the rectification of personal data in case they have been processed in an incomplete and wrong manner and to request the notification of the third parties within this scope to whom the personal data have been transferred,
- Request the deletion or destruction of personal data if the grounds permitting the processing of personal data no longer exist within the scope of the Law numbered 6698 and all other related provisions of law and to request the notification of the third parties within this scope to whom the personal data have been transferred,
- Object to any adverse result that occurs exclusively from the analysis the processed data via automatic systems,
- Claim compensation if any damage is incurred due to unlawful processing of personal data.
